All participants must:

- be a national of the following countries: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, China, Indonesia, India, Malaysia, Nepal, Thailand, Pakistan or EU countries
- have not resided nor have carried out their main activity (studies, work, etc) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years in one of the European countries at the time of submitting their application to the partnership.
- have sufficient knowledge of the language of the courses or of one of the languages currently spoken in the hosting countries.
